

## Important Vaccine Support

When faced with relatives/friends who have strong opinions (and pressure) in favor of vaccines here are some good questions to keep handy.

**Decisive Mom/Dad:** “I’ve decided that I prefer not to discuss the topic of vaccines unless someone has done some basic research. We’ve all heard a lot of information about vaccines in the media, but if we want to get to the truth, it requires some due diligence. So, before you tell me your thoughts, I’d like to ask you just a couple of questions.”

### #1 What is MRC-5 and WI-38 and which vaccines contain it?

Answer- MRC-5 and WI-38, aka, human diploid cells (HDC), are fetal cell lines from aborted babies used in the development of these vaccines: Hepatitis A (Havrix, Vaqta), Hepatitis A-Hepatitis B (Twinrix), MMRV (Pro-Quad), Rabies (Imovax), Poliovirus inactivated (Poliovax), Varicella (Varivax), Zoster (Zostavax), Rubella (Meruvax II) and combination vaccines containing it.

### #2 Name three significant ingredients of concern in vaccines.

-**Aluminum** in a variety of forms is added as an adjuvant (enhancer) and “carries a risk for autoimmunity, long-term brain inflammation, and associated neurological complications and may thus have profound and widespread adverse health consequences.” <http://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/pubmed/21568886>

-**Polysorbate 80** is a surfactant which is known to facilitate access to the blood brain barrier, has been linked to sterility, can suppress your immune system, and can cause severe allergic reaction. <http://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/pubmed/16400901>

-**Glutaraldehyde** is a toxic chemical used as a toxin detoxifier in vaccines. It is also used as a cleaner for oil and gas pipelines and medical equipment.

### #3 What are pentavalent & hexavalent vaccines?

Answer- Vaccines which contain either 5 (Pentavalent) or 6 (Hexavalent) different disease antigens in one injection: diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, hepatitis B, polio and Haemophilus influenzae (Hib).

### #4 AT what age are babies recommended to receive multi-valent vaccines?

Answer- At 2, 4, and 6 months along with other vaccines. Pediarix and Infanrix hexa, both manufactured by GSK, are the current favorites.

### #5 How much aluminum is in hexavalent vaccines?

Answer- 0.820 mg, or four times the EPA limits for 1 L drinking water (0.05-0.2 mg/L)

### #6 How many vaccines are mandated for babies up to 2 years old?

Answer- 49 vaccines all loaded with toxic chemicals.
